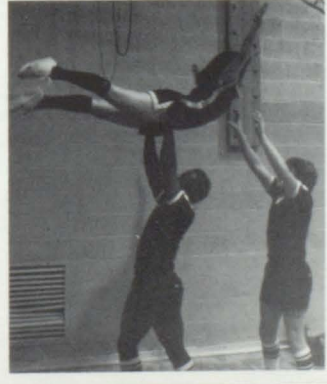
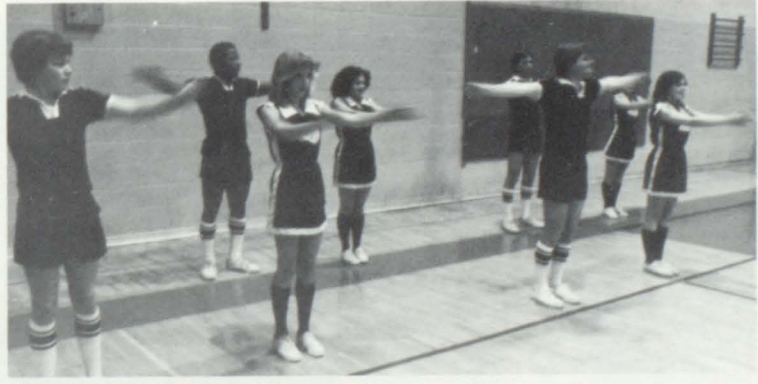
CO-ED CHEERLEADING

Not since 1956, when Ed Boyd and Tom Murphy were members of the squad has there been a co-ed cheerleading group.

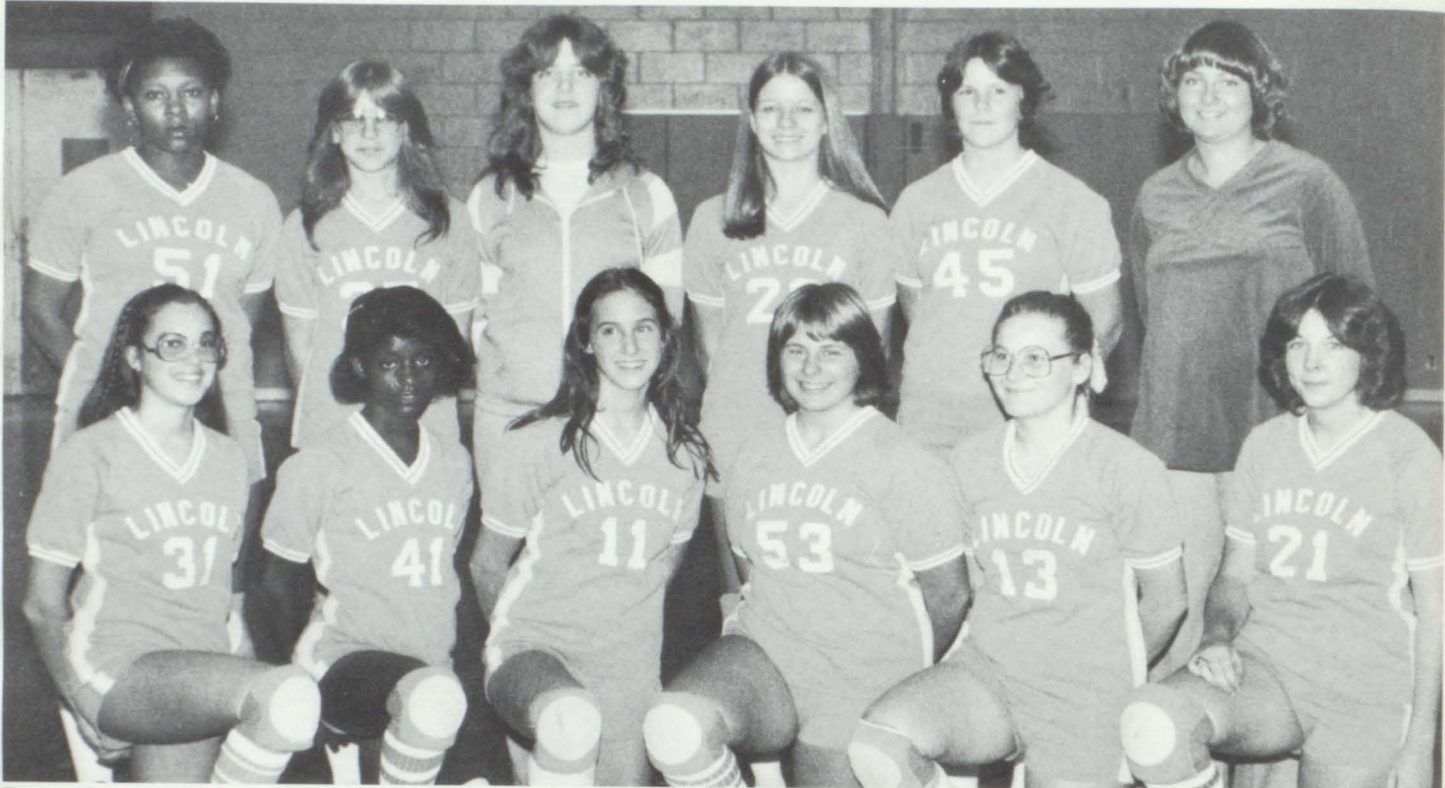

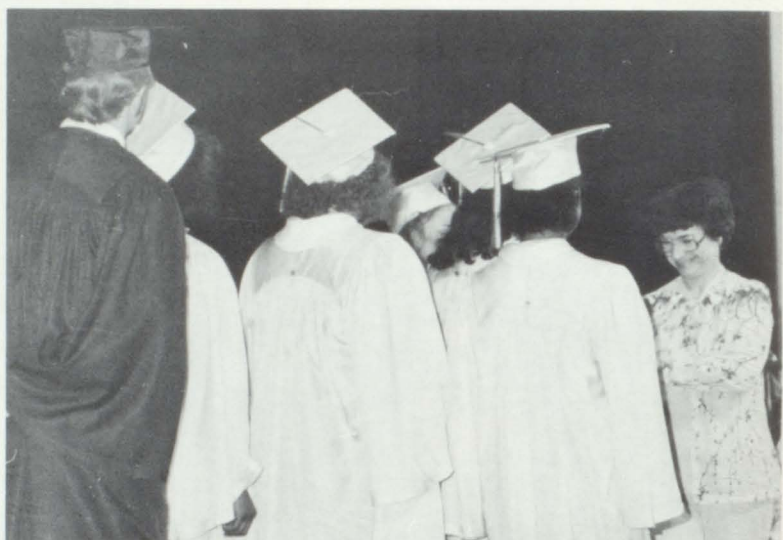
