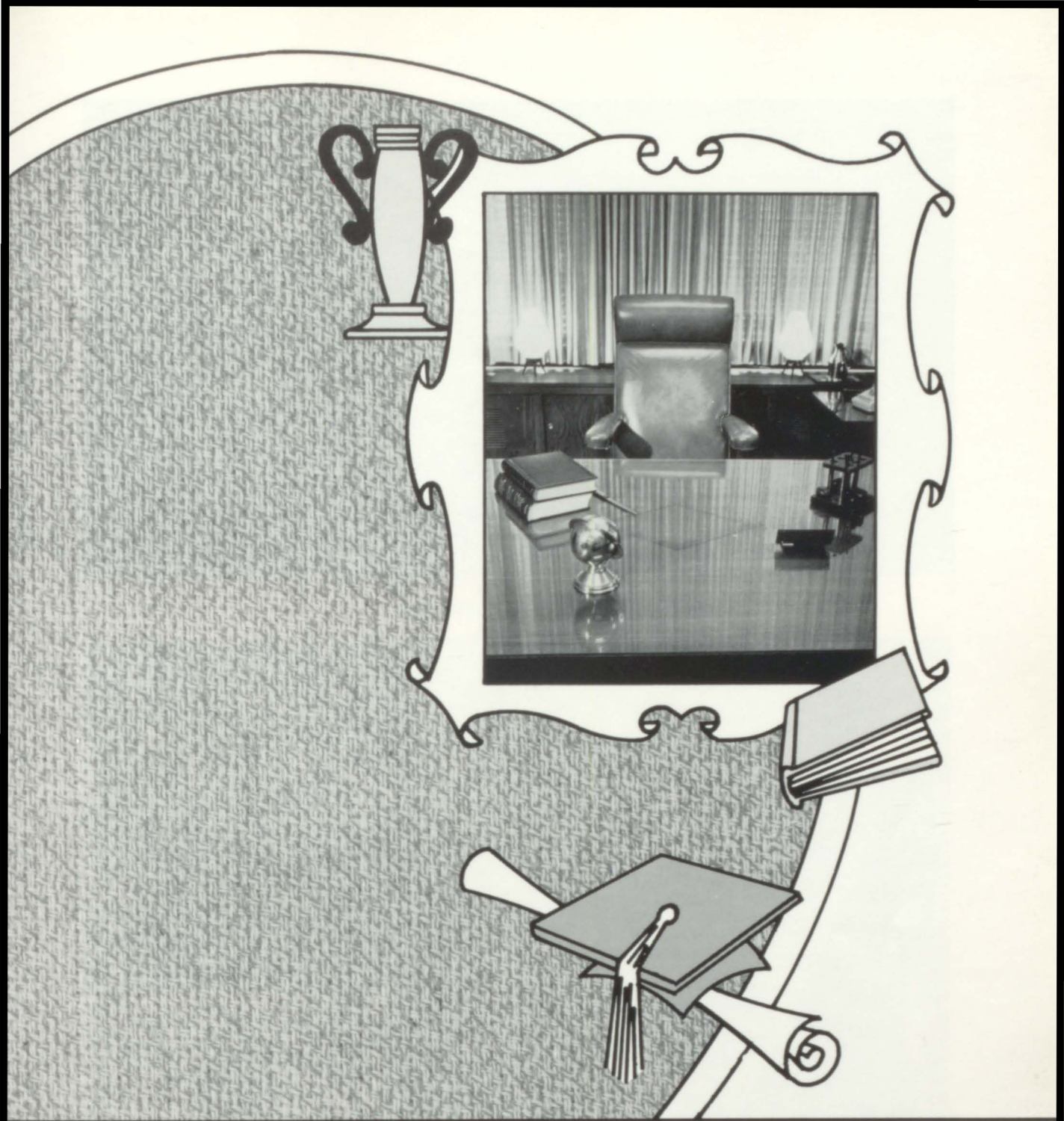
FIRST ICE STORM OF THE YEAR — OCT. 30, 1963
